FACTS CONSTITUTING Pursuant to Rule 7.1 of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure, the undersigned affiant(s) being duly sworn deposes and says that he has reason to believe that the above-named person has committed the offense of violating Ark Code Ann. 5-13-202 Battery 2st Degree in Greene County Arkansas against the peace and dignity of the State of Arkansas.

REASONABLE CAUSE

On January 22, 2014, during a meeting at Phillips Auction on Greene 721 Road, an altercation occurred between defendant, RONNIE WOOD, and Greene County Judge JERRY SHIPMAN.

According to a statement by Judge SHIPMAN he was physically attacked by WOOD. SHIPMAN reported he is 72 years old. He said the attack and physical force to him, by WOOD, caused him to wrench his left side and cause severe pain. He added that the force caused him to seek medical treatment. He added the attack also caused pain to his lower back, numbness in his left leg, and soreness to his right shoulder.

Witnesses to the assault indicated WOOD and SHIPMAN were arguing when WOOD approached SHIPMAN and pushed/struck SHIPMAN with his hand to SHIPMAN'S right shoulder area. Witnesses reported SHIPMAN was threatened by WOOD to go outside the building and fight. SHIPMAN stated when WOOD threatened physical violence he was frightened.

WOOD stated to affiant he did engage in a verbal altercation with SHIPMAN which did lead to him pushing SHIPMAN.
